

Slave to the World or Freedom in Jesus Christ

Whoever submits to the world submits to lies, which is sinning and to the devil, for the devil is the liar, the sinner from the beginning. Anyone who says they don't sin is lying. Anyone who says they don't lie is sinning. This is why the Son of God descended, to destroy the works of the devil.

1 John 3, ⁸ He that committeth sin is of the devil: for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

Mark 10, ⁴⁵ For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

Colossians 2, ¹⁴ Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross.

Whoever remains in sin and rejects Jesus as his personal Savior, remains a slave to the world and the prince of the world is the devil. This is his temporary kingdom.

Ephesians 2, ² Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

Those who remain in sin join the kingdom of the devil and after death, they go to hell, which is the kingdom of the devil and sinners.

2 Corinthians 4, ⁴ In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

Revelation 12, ⁹ And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Hebrews 2, ¹⁴ Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil.

James 4, ⁷ Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
